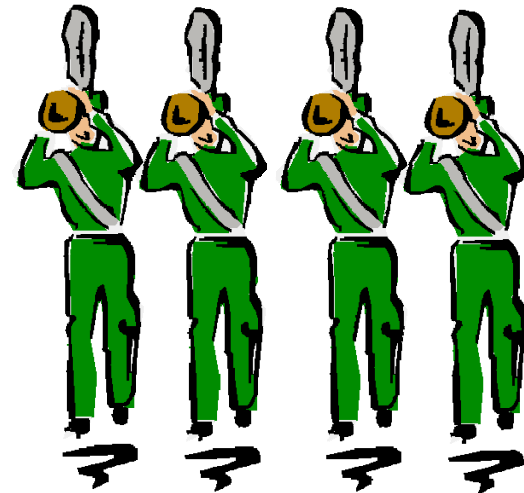
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# CPHS Timberwolf Band

- Cedar Park High School opened in 1998 with 300 total students and a band of 50. Student population growth has been dramatic and is projected to reach 2,500 in 2008.

"Students with coursework/experience in music performance scored 52 points higher on the verbal portion of the SAT and 37 points higher on the math portion than students with no coursework or experience in the arts. The difference in scores increased with the number of years involved.
